FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO JHARKHAND FOR MEDICINAL PLANTS AND HERBS CULTIVATION

1610 SHRI DEEPAK PRAKASH:

Will the Minister of AYURVEDA, YOGA AND NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of financial assistance provided to promote cultivation of medicinal plants and herbs in Jharkhand during the last two years;
- (b) the quantum of medicinal plants exported from Jharkhand during the said period;
- (c) the steps taken to promote the production of Ayurvedic and herbal medicines in the country, particularly in Jharkhand; and
- (d) the schemes under which the Central Government encourages farmers to cultivate medicinal plants?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (IC) OF THE MINISTRY OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS AND ADDITIONAL CHARGE OF MINISTER OF STATE (IC) OF THE MINISTRY OF AYURVEDA, YOGA & NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY (SHRI KIREN RIJIJU)

- (a): No fund was released to Jharkhand for cultivation of medicinal plants during last two years, as no Annual Action Plan has been received from Jharkhand for cultivation of medicinal plants.
- (b): Export of AYUSH and Herbal product from Jharkhand during the last two financial year and current financial year (April December 20) as received from DGFT is given below-

- (c): Government of India is implementing Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National AYUSH Mission (NAM) in the country through State and UT Governments for promotion and development of AYUSH system. Under NAM, there is provision for financial assistance to strengthen State/Government Ayurveda Siddha Unani & Homoeopathy (ASU&H) Pharmacies/ State Government ASU&H Cooperatives, State Government ASU&H PSU's in the country including Jharkhand. State and UT Governments may avail eligible financial assistance by projecting the same through State Annual Action Plan (SAAP) as per NAM guidelines.
- (d): Ministry of AYUSH, Government of India is implementing Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National AYUSH Mission (NAM). Under 'Medicinal Plants' component of the NAM scheme supporting market driven cultivation of prioritized medicinal plants in identified cluster/zones with in selected districts of States and implemented in a mission mode. As per the scheme guidelines, the support is provided for:
 - (i) Cultivation of prioritized medicinal plants on farmer's land.
 - (ii) Establishment of nurseries with backward linkages for raising and supply of quality planting material.
 - (iii) Post-harvest management with forward linkages.
 - (iv) Primary processing, marketing infrastructure etc.

Under this scheme, subsidy @30%, 50% and 75% of cultivation cost of specific plant species is provided for cultivation of 140 medicinal plants.
