- (a) & (b) Government of India has taken many steps to commemorate 125th Birth Anniversary of Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose as follows:
- i. Inauguration of Nirbhik Subhas ('Irrepressible Subhas') – A Multimedia permanent exhibition in the 6 galleries at Victoria Memorial Hall, Kolkata with 3D projection mapping show by Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi Ji on 23rd January 2021
 - ii. Unveiling of book 'Letters of Netaji'
 - iii. Release of Commemorative coin&stamp; and
 - iv. Gala Cultural Program celebrating Netaji's legacy and featuring many eminent artists

Cuttack is one of the places under consideration for commemorating 125th Birth Anniversary of Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose.
