Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the National Polio Immunisation programme has been deferred or suspended, if so, the reasons therefor
- (b) the date when the National Immunisation Day (NID) will be conducted which was scheduled for January 17, 2020, and subsequently postponed
- (c) whether the Ministry has assessed the potential adverse impact that suspension or deferment of the programme will have on preventing polio in children and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

- (a) & (b): The National Polio Immunisation programme was rescheduled from 17th January 2021 to 31st January 2021 since the massive countrywide COVID-19 vaccination drive which is world's largest immunization exercise was rolled out from 16th January 2021. The National Immunisation Day (NID) was conducted successfully on 31st January 2021.
- (c) & (d): There was no adverse impact due to rescheduling of NID which was successfully conducted within two weeks and more than 15.8 crore children were vaccinated during this NID.
