**FUNDS RELEASED TO PRIVATE HEALTHCARE SECTOR UNDER AYUSHMAN
BHARAT SCHEME**

- (a) the total amount of funds released to private healthcare sector from the date of launch of Ayushman Bharat Scheme and
- (b) the details of companies or hospitals to which the said funds were released?

(a): Under the operational framework of Ayushman Bharat- Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY), Central share of scheme-related expenditure for the implementation of the scheme is released in the form of Grants-in-aid to various State Health Agencies (SHAs). SHAs which operate under trust mode directly reimburse the claims raised by AB-PMJAY empanelled hospitals within their respective jurisdiction. In case of insurance mode implementation, SHAs pay the premium to the insurance company which subsequently reimburses the empanelled hospitals against claims raised.

As on 5th March 2021, a total of Rs. 7,327.08 crore has been reimbursed as part of the claims raised by private hospitals empanelled under the scheme.
