**SPONSORSHIP TO NTPC KENDRIYA VIDYALAYA**

**1736. SHRI K.C. VENUGOPAL:**

Will the Minister of **POWER**  
be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Ministry has received any communication from National Thermal Power Corporation (NTPC) to stop sponsorship to the NTPC Kendriya Vidyalaya, Kayamkulam in Alappuzha;
- (b) whether Government is aware that the stoppage of sponsorship by NTPC would lead to the closure of Kendriya Vidyalaya, Kayamkulam, Alappuzha;
- (c) if so, whether Government is ready to continue with the sponsorship to the said Kendriya Vidyalaya; and
- (d) if not, whether Government will chalk out an alternative mode of sponsorship in consultation with the Ministry of Education, if so, the details thereof?

**(a) to (d) :** In respect of Kendriya Vidyalaya, Kayamkulam in Alappuzha, National Thermal Power Corporation Limited (NTPC) has conveyed its intention to terminate the agreement entered into between NTPC & Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS) with effect from academic year 2022-23 to KVS, New Delhi as NTPC Kayamkulam has not been generating power for more than six years due to lack of schedule of power from Kerala and is under reserve shutdown. It is upto the Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan to decide and explore other alternatives for running the school.
