- (d) the district-wise number of unemployed youth from SC/ST category who have been provided jobs in the job fairs organised district-wise in Rajasthan during last three years?**

(a) to (d): Government (Ministry of Labour and Employment) is implementing the National Career Service (NCS) Project to provide a variety of employment related services like job matching, career counselling, vocational guidance, information on skill development courses, etc. Under the NCS project assistance is also provided to States/UTs for organising job fairs.

As per the information received from the Government of Rajasthan, the Employment Department of the State Government is organising Job Fairs every month in each district. The year-wise details are as under: -
