- (a) whether providing clean fuel to each household in the country is on the priority of Government:
- (b) the State-wise details of clean fuel provided to the households in the country at present; and
- (c) whether Government has set any target in this regard?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS (SHRI DHARMENDRA PRADHAN)

(a) to (c) Release of LPG connections is a continuous process and LPG distributors are under instructions to immediately register any request for new LPG connection. In order to provide clean cooking fuel to poor households, the Government had launched Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (PMUY) in 2016 and the target to provide 8 crore deposit free LPG connections has already been achieved in September, 2019. Further, Hon'ble Finance Minister in the budget announcement made on 1st February, 2021, has announced to provide 1 crore more LPG connections under PMUY in addition to 8 crore LPG connection already released.

As on 01.02.2021, total domestic Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG) consumer is 28.82 crore in the country. Apart from LPG, 70.75 lakh domestic consumers are also using Piped Natural Gas (PNG). State-UT-wise details domestic LPG consumers as on 01.02.2021 are at **Annexure**.
