#### COMPUTERISATION AND MODERNISATION OF POST OFFICES

## 1125 DR. FAUZIA KHAN:

Will the Minister of Communications be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has undertaken any programme for the computerisation and modernisation of Post Offices in the country;
- (b) if so, the State-wise details thereof, particularly in Maharashtra;
- (c) the number of Post Offices computerised as on date in each State, particularly Maharashtra; and
- (d) the number of Post Offices yet to be computerised?

#### ANSWER

# MINISTER OF STATE FOR COMMUNICATIONS, EDUCATION AND ELECTRONICS & INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (SHRI SANJAY DHOTRE)

- (a) Yes. The Department of Posts have modernized and computerised the Post Offices to provide better postal services in the country under the IT Modernization Project.
- (b) & (c) The details are as under:
  - i. All the 25,409 Departmental Post Offices in the country have been computerized. All 2110 Departmental Post Offices in the state of Maharashtra are computerised. State/UT-wise number of Departmental Post Offices computerised is annexed as Annexure-I. The Department has computerised and modernized 1,29,157 Branch Post offices by providing Subscriber Identification Module (SIM) based Handheld Point of Sale devices for carrying out postal and financial transactions using central server architecture under Digital Advancement of Rural Post Office for A New India (DARPAN) Project. In Maharashtra, 10,573 Branch Post Offices have been rolled out under DARPAN project. State/ UT-wise number of Branch Post Offices rolled out under DARPAN is annexed as Annexure-II.
  - ii. The project includes providing Central Server based integrated, modular and scalable solution for all the operations of Department of Posts including Mails, Human Resource, Banking, Insurance and Finance and Accounts. It also involves creation of IT Infrastructure like Data Centre, Disaster Recovery Centre, setting up of a Wide Area Network (WAN) and providing solar powered and portable hand-held computing devices (Micro ATM compliant) to all the Branch Post Offices.

- iii. Post Offices are providing Core Banking Services (CBS) to the Post Office Savings Bank (POSB) customers enabling them to transact their POSB accounts from any post office across the country.
- iv. **1000** ATMs have been installed, with at least one in each District Headquarters in the country. 75 ATMs have been installed in Maharashtra Circle. These ATMs are interoperable with other banks.
- v. Internet banking services, (e-banking) have been made available for POSB customers from 14.12.2018. Through the e-banking facility, POSB account holders can make deposits into Sukanya Samriddhi Yojana (SSY) and the Post Office Public Provident Fund (PPF) accounts online from their POSB savings account.
- vi. The POSB customers have also been provided with the facility of Mobile Banking from 15.10.2019.
- vii. Postal Life Insurance (PLI) services are being provided through Core Insurance Solution (CIS) which has been rolled out in all thePost offices and through this solution, the customers can make premium payment at any post office and has also enabled central processing centres to provide faster claim settlement and after-sales service.
- (d) All the Departmental post offices have been computerised, However, 1789 new Branch Post Offices opened during the year 2019-2020 in the Left Wing Extremism (LWE) Districts and 1556 Branch Post Offices located at Technically Not Feasible (TNF) locations where connectivity is yet to be established, are yet to be supplied with Subscriber Identification Module (SIM) based Hand Held Devices and hence are still to be computerised.
