#### OPTICAL FIBRE LAID UNDER THE NOFN PROJECT

#### 1128 SHRI SYED ZAFAR ISLAM:

Will the Minister of Communications be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of optical fibre laid so far under the National Optical Fibre Network (NOFN) Project and the time frame to achieve the remaining targets;
- (b) the number of Gram Panchayats connected with broadband and WiFi hotspots so far under the said project in Uttar Pradesh, the details thereof; and
- (c) the number of Gram Panchayats of Uttar Pradesh yet to be connected under the said project, the details thereof, district-wise?

#### **ANSWER**

# MINISTER OF STATE FOR COMMUNICATIONS, EDUCATION AND ELECTRONICS & INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (SHRI SANJAY DHOTRE)

(a) BharatNet project, earlier known as National Optical Fibre Network (NOFN), is being implemented in a phased manner to provide broadband connectivity at all the Gram Panchayats (approx. 2, 50,000) in the country. Bharat Broadband Network Limited (BBNL) is the Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) for execution of the project. The implementation of the Phase-I of the BharatNet project has been done over Optical Fibre Cable (OFC) through three Central Public Sector Undertakings (CPSUs), viz. Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited (BSNL), RailTel Corporation of India Ltd. (RailTel) and Power Grid Corporation of India Ltd (PGCIL). The Cabinet on July 19, 2017 approved a modified strategy for implementation of the BharatNet project. Accordingly, the implementation of Phase-II is being done through State-led Model, Private Sector Model and CPSU-led Model by using an Optimal mix of media (OFC, Radio and satellite).

As on 01.02.2021, under BharatNet project (Phase-I & II), by laying 4,94,879 km OFC, a total number of 1,49,026 Gram Panchayats (including BHQs) have been made Service Ready. Further 3,330 GPs have been made Service Ready on satellite media. Thus, a total number of 1,52,356 villages (i.e. Gram Panchayats including BHQs) have been made Service Ready in the country.

The BharatNet project was envisaged to be completed by August 2021. However, this time will now be extended as the pace of completion is affected by lockdown and restrictions on movement imposed by the various Governments due to COVID-19.

- (b) In Uttar Pradesh, as on 01.02.2021, under BharatNet project (Phase-I & II), by laying 84,324 km OFC, a total number of 31,032 Gram Panchayats (including BHQs) have been made Service Ready. Further, 33 Gram Panchayats (GPs) have been made Service Ready on Satellite media. Thus, a total number of 31,065 Gram Panchayats (including BHQs) have been made Service Ready in Uttar Pradesh. Furthermore, Wi-Fi hotspots have been installed at 26,897 GPs and 1,03,492 Fibre to the Home (FTTH) connections have been provided.
- (c) The District-wise details of the Gram Panchayats (including BHQs) of Uttar Pradesh, yet to be connected under the said project, are given in **Annexure-I**.
