WASTAGE OF INDUSTRIAL RESOURCES

2934. SHRI K.P. MUNUSAMY:

Will the Minister of **HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that there is a large scale wastage of industrial resources because of lack of skilled and trained labour;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons for lack of skilled and trained labour; and
- (c) whether there are any proposal pending with Government in this regard?

(a) to (c): Information as sought is not being collated by the Department of Heavy Industry (DHI). However, as per the information received from the National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC), the total number of candidates enrolled for skill training and those trained in the 39 sectors as on 19th January, 2021 are given as under:
