Common entrance test for undergraduate studies in Central Universities

Will the Minister of *Education* be pleased to state:

- (a) whether after the introduction of the new National Education Policy, Government is exploring the feasibility of holding a common entrance test for undergraduate admissions across Central Universities:
- (b) if so, whether Government has sought views of eminent educationists and experts in this regard; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the time frame by which a common entrance test is likely to be conducted for varsities?

ANSWER MINISTER OF EDUCATION (Shri Ramesh Pokhriyal 'Nishank')

(a) to (c): Yes sir. This Ministry has requested University Grants Commission to set up a Committee including Vice Chancellors of old and new Central Universities to go into the nitty-gritty of implementation of National Education Policy recommendations about common entrance test at Under graduate level in Central Universities.
