Schools without vocational training courses

1162: Shri Bhaskar Rao Nekkanti:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the State-wise total number of schools without vocational training courses in percentage of total number of schools;
- (b) whether vocational training courses are being initiated in such schools; and
- (c) the number of schools that have started vocational training during the last 3 years?

(a): Under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme 'Samagra Shiksha', Vocational Education has been approved in 12854 Secondary and Senior Secondary Schools. State/UT wise number and percentage of such schools without vocational education is given at Annexure.

(b) & (c): Under the scheme, Vocational Education in schools is approved based on the proposals of the States/UTs in their Annual Work Plan and Budget. Vocational Education courses have been started in 5098 Schools during the last three years from 2017-18 to 2019-20.
