(a) & (b): No, Sir.

The result of Civil Services Examination – 2019 was declared by the Union Public Service Commission on 04.08.2020, thereby recommending in the first instance 829 candidates (including 129 SC and 67 ST candidates).

Further, as per the relevant provisions of the Civil Services Examination Rules – 2019, 89 more candidates (which include 01 SC and 00 ST Candidates) were recommended on 04.01.2021 by the Commission, from the Consolidated Reserve List of Civil Services Examination – 2019, as per the requisition by Department of Personnel and Training after allocation of services to the candidates recommended in the first instance.
