### AGRICULTURAL CREDIT TO FARMERS

1952. Shri N. R. Elango:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) the disbursal of agricultural credit to farmers in 2019-20, State-wise;
- (b) the size/class of farmers who have benefitted from agricultural credit and the quantum of credit for each class during 2019-20, State-wise;
- (c) the amount of agricultural credit which was planned to be disbursed during 2019-2020 across States and the actual disbursal in 2019-2020; and
- (d) the proportion of agricultural credit in the priority sector lending across States during 2019-2020?

#### ANSWER

MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE (SHRI NARENDRA SINGH TOMAR)

- (a) to (c): As per the available information, 52% of total agriculture credit was disbursed to small and marginal farmers. Size/ class-wise categorization of agriculture credit is not maintained. The total agriculture credit disbursement target during the year 2019-20 was 13.50 lakh crore. The actual disbursement during 2019-20 was 13.93 lakh crore. Statewise target and disbursement during the year 2019-20 is given in **Annexure-I**.
- (d): As per Reserve Bank of India Master Directions on Priority Sector Lending (PSL), all Scheduled Commercial Banks (including Regional Rural Banks, Small Finance Banks, Local Area Banks and Primary (Urban) Co-operative Banks other than Salary Earners' Banks) are to extend 40% of ANBC (Adjusted Net Bank Credit) or CEOBE (Credit Equivalent of Off-Balance Sheet Exposures), whichever is higher for total priority sector advances. Within this 18% of ANBC or CEOBE, whichever is higher, needs to be extended to agriculture sector. Within 18% target for agriculture, a target of 8% of ANBC or CEOBE whichever is higher is prescribed for Small and Marginal Farmers.
