**RANKING OF NHs**

2229. SHRI PRABHAKAR REDDY VEMIREDDY:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the Ministry at the behest of Prime Minister's Office (PMO) decided to rank National Highways (NHs);
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the details of parameters that are going to be taken into account while ranking NHs; and
- (d) whether any incentive would be given to those stretches which have better ranks?

- (a) to (b) Rating of National Highways under the purview of NHAI has been conducted with a view to improving quality of National Highways and providing higher level of services on the highways as per Government initiatives.
- (c) Highway Efficiency, Highway Safety and User Services are the parameters to assess the efficiency of the completed corridors on a standard rating scale.
- (d) At present, no incentives are offered on the basis of highway rating.
