WORKS UNDER PMGSY IN JHARKHAND

2069 SHRI SAMIR ORAON:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the total length of roads constructed in Jharkhand under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) during the last three years, the year-wise details thereof;
- (b) the number of villages still not connected with roads, the details thereof; and
- (c) the details of action plan of Government to connect all villages of Jharkhand by roads under the above scheme?

- (a) The total length of roads constructed in Jharkhand under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) during the last three years and the current year (as on 09/03/2021) is as under:

Year	Road length constructed (in km)
2017-18	4,519.15
2018-19	3,571.42
2019-20	1,408.18
2020-21 as on 09.03.2021	1,455.93
Total	10,954.68

(b)&(c): Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) is a one-time special intervention of Government of India to provide connectivity, by way of a single all-weather road, to the eligible unconnected rural habitations in the core network. The unit of connectivity under this scheme is habitation and not village. Hence, the data of connectivity of villages is not maintained under the scheme.

The detail of eligible sanctioned habitations, connected habitations and balance habitations to be connected in respect of the state of Jharkhand is as under-

Eligible sanctioned habitations (in No.)	Connected habitations (in No.)	Balance habitations to be connected (in No.)
10,981	10,936	45

Balance habitations are targeted for connectivity by 31st March, 2022.
