GROWTH RATE OF RURAL WAGES

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the growth rate of rural wages in India since 2016, year-wise;
- (b) whether the growth rate of rural wages has declined since 2016;
- (c) if so, whether Government has investigated the reasons for the decline; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (d) Labour Bureau, Ministry of Labour & Employment has been compiling and maintaining average wage rate data in respect of selected agricultural and non-agricultural occupations on the basis of the data collected by the Field Operation Division (FOD) of National Statistical Office (NSO) from a fixed set of 600 sample villages spread over 20 states.

The average wage rates for the year 2016 to 2020 in respect of non-agricultural Labourers are given below:

Annual Average daily wage rate for Non-agricultural laborers

2016	257.95	4.51
2017	271.17	5.13
2018	282.04	4.01
2019	291.87	3.49
2020 (till November 2020*)	310.19	6.28

(\* Due to COVID-19 pandemic, the data for the month of April, 2020 could not be compiled; therefore calculation for the year 2020 is based on the average of 11 months.)

Under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (Mahatma Gandhi NREGA), the wage rates for beneficiaries of Mahatma Gandhi NREG Scheme are revised annually, based on change in Consumer Price Index for Agricultural Labour (CPI-AL) published by Labour Bureau, Ministry of Labour & Employment for States/UTs. The wage rates are made applicable from 1<sup>st</sup> April of each Financial Year.

The wage rates for the financial year 2020-21 have been revised effective from 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2020. A table indicating Mahatma Gandhi NREGA wage rates for States/UTs for the FY 2019-20 and 2020-21 is given at **annexure**.
