# Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) the progress of PM's National Council on Skill Development which aims to skill 500 million people in India by 2022;
- (b) the list of number of people skilled in the financial year 2020-21, State- wise;
- (c) whether any skilling initiatives are being contemplated or implemented specifically for tribals, in particular the tribals of Assam who constitute 12.4% of the State's population; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

#### **ANSWER**

## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI R.K. SINGH)

(a) to (d): The target of skilling 500 million people in India by 2022 was set under the National Skill Development Policy 2009. Subsequently, the National Policy on Skill Development and Entrepreneurship 2015 came into force with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2015. Under the 2015 Policy, the target for skilling from 2015-2022 was set at 402.87 million, comprising 104.62 million new entrants to the workforce who need to be skilled to meet industry requirements, and 298.25 million existing workforce who need Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL), re-skilling, up-skilling and skilling.

The Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) is implementing schemes viz. Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), Jan Shikshan Sansthan (JSS) Scheme and National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS) for skill development of all sections of the society, including tribals. The State/ Union Territory (UT) - wise details of people who have benefitted under PMKVY, JSS and NAPS in the financial year 2020-21 are given in **Annexure II**, **Annexure II** and **Annexure III** respectively.

Under PMKVY, 45,233 Scheduled Tribes (ST) candidates have been trained/ oriented in the State of Assam from 2016-17 to 2020-21 (as on 19.01.2021). Under JSS scheme, 862 ST candidates have been trained in the State of Assam from 2018-19 to 2020-21. Under NAPS, 2,607 youths have been trained in the State of Assam in 2020-21 (up to 28.02.2021), including 7% from the ST category. In addition, under the fee-based market-led model of the National Skill Development Corporation, 5,081 tribal candidates have been trained in the State of Assam in 2019-20 and 2020-21.
