Review of projects under MSMEs in Karnataka

2990. Shri Iranna Kadadi:

Will the Minister of *Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises* be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has decided to review ongoing/pending projects under Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) in the country particularly in Karnataka and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the total number of such projects sanctioned and pending in the sector as on date;
- (c) whether Government is aware that the various projects are pending due to non-sanction of bank loans in Karnataka; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the steps being taken by Government to review such projects with Karnataka and the concerned banks?

ANSWER

(SHRI NITIN GADKARI)

(a): The Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) does not make any investment in any project in the country including Karnataka. The MSME sector consists of private players and the investments in this sector are made by the entrepreneurs themselves. Promotion and development of enterprises is a State subject. However, the Central Government supplements the efforts of the State/UT Governments through various schemes, programmes and policy initiatives for promotion, development and enhancing the competitiveness of MSMEs in the country.
