CSR WORK UNDERTAKEN BY PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SECTOR COMPANIES

QUESTION

2257. SHRI SUJEET KUMAR:

Will the Minister of CORPORATE AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the amount of funds allotted and utilized during the last three years by different public and private sector companies under Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR);
- (b) the details of the amount spent by the private and public companies during each of the last three years, Statewise, district-wise and work-wise; and
- (c) the total number of violations of CSR provisions done by private and public companies during each of the last three years, and the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): The Government provides the broad framework for Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) through Section 135 of the Companies Act, 2013 ('Act'), Schedule VII of the Act and the Companies (CSR Policy) Rules, 2014. CSR is a Board driven process and the Board of the company is empowered to plan, decide, execute and monitor CSR activities of the company based on the recommendation of its CSR Committee. As per filings made by the Companies in the MCA21 registry, the CSR spent by various public and private sector companies during last three financial years 2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20 respectively are given below:

State/UT-wise and Sector-wise CSR spent by various public and private sector companies during last three financial years 2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20 are at Annexure – I and Annexure – II respectively. All data related to CSR filed by companies in the MCA21 registry, including District-wise, is available in public domain and can be accessed at www.csr.gov.in.

The CSR architecture is disclosure based and CSR mandated companies are required to file details of CSR activities annually in the MCA21 registry. Whenever any violation of CSR provisions is reported, action against such non-compliant Companies are initiated as per provisions of the Act after due examination of records and following due process of law. All CSR related defaults are compoundable. So far, sanction for prosecution has been accorded in 366 cases. Of these, 148 applications for compounding have been made and 75 cases have been compounded.
