**INOCULATIONS OF DOCTORS, HEALTH WORKERS AND  
FRONTLINE WARRIORS**

**2315 MS. ARPITA GHOSH:**

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of persons who have been vaccinated till 25th Feb, 2021;
- (b) the details in terms of doctors, healthworkers & frontline warriors;
- (c) whether vaccination rate has reached to the target set by Government; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) & (b): Till 25<sup>th</sup> February 2021, total of 1,34,72,643 vaccine doses were administered out of which 1,14,39,649 beneficiaries had received the first dose of vaccination and 20,32,994 beneficiaries had received the second dose of vaccination against COVID-19. The details of vaccination are as follows:

- i. Among the Health Care Workers, 66,21,418 beneficiaries received the first dose and 20,32,994 beneficiaries received the second dose of vaccination.
- ii. Among the Front Line Workers, 48,18,231 beneficiaries received first dose of vaccination.

(c): The current rate of COVID-19 vaccination is satisfactory and is being further increased through increase in number of COVID-19 Vaccination Centres (CVCs) in both Government and Private health facilities.

(d): In view of reply at (c) above, question does not arise.
