**INDEPENDENT AGREEMENTS BETWEEN STATES AND COVID-19 VACCINE  
MANUFACTURERS**

**2349 SHRI ANAND SHARMA:**

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government plans to allow or facilitate the States to enter into independent agreements with COVID-19 vaccine manufacturers to accelerate country wide inoculation
- (b) if so, the details thereof
- (c) the number of vaccine doses distributed to each State as of February 1, 2021 and vaccination targets for the year 2021, month-wise, State-wise and
- (d) whether Government has received any requests from industry concerning facilitation of such independent agreements with States?

**ANSWER**

(a) & (b): Government has advised all States and UTs to not enter into independent agreement with COVID-19 vaccine manufacturers for procurement of vaccines.

(c): As on 1<sup>st</sup> February 2021, a total of 214.9 lakh doses of COVID-19 vaccines were distributed to States and UTs, the details of the same are at Annexure-1.

The COVID-19 Vaccination is an ongoing and dynamic process, which is being expanded to include beneficiary groups as prioritized by National Expert Group on Vaccine Administration for COVID-19 (NEGVAC), hence, the targets remain dynamic in nature. The State/UT-wise target beneficiaries registered for COVID-19 vaccination are at Annexure-2.

(d): No request has been received from industry regarding facilitation of any independent agreements with States.
