(a) and (b): Preliminary Engineering cum Traffic (PET) survey for the proposed new broad gauge railway line (136 km) from Raxaul (India) to Kathmandu (Nepal) has been completed in April, 2019. After examination of PET survey report, it has been decided by Government of India to have final Location Survey (FLS) that has been sanctioned by Ministry of Railways in December, 2019 for preparing the Detailed Project Report (DPR). The project is not yet sanctioned.
