PMKVY IN RAJASTHAN

2871. SHRI NEERAJ DANGI:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of people who have been trained under the Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) during the last three years, year-wise and district-wise;
- (b) the amount of funds allocated to the State of Rajasthan under the said scheme during the last three years, year-wise;
- (c) the number of people who have received training and employment under the said scheme; and
- (d) whether any study or analysis has been done keeping in mind the training being imparted in the said scheme and the needs of the people of Rajasthan, if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI R. K. SINGH)

(a) and (c) Under Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) 2.0 during the last three years (FY 2017-18 to 2019-20), 87.39 lakh candidates have been trained / oriented across the country including 7.51 lakh candidates in the State of Rajasthan. The district-wise number of candidates trained/oriented in the State of Rajasthan under PMKVY 2.0, as on 19.01.2021, is given at *Annexure*.

Under placement-linked Short Term Training (STT) component of PMKVY 2.0, as on 19.01.2021, out of 36.04 lakh certified candidates, 18.95 lakh candidates have been placed across the country. Similarly, in the State of Rajasthan, out of 2.82 lakh certified candidates in STT, 1.51 lakh candidates have been placed.

- (b) PMKVY has two components namely; Centrally Sponsored Centrally Managed (CSSM) and Centrally Sponsored State Managed (CSSM). CSCM component does not have provision of State-wise allocation of funds. While under CSSM component of PMKVY 2.0, out of total revised allocation of Rs. 70.96 crore, Rs. 26.19 crore has been released to the State of Rajasthan based on their training performance.
- (d) Under the PMKVY scheme, sector-wise and state-wise Skill Gap studies are conducted by National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC), based on which the training plan is made. This has been further decentralized under PMKVY 3.0, where District Skill Committees have been entrusted with the task of identifying local demand, based on which training is arranged in the district.
