STEPS TAKEN UNDER NPDD

- (a) the steps taken by the Ministry under the National Programme for Dairy Development (NPDD);
- (b) the number of bulk milk coolers and milk testing centers established under the programme; and
- (c) the State-wise details thereof and the details of progress made under the programme?

ANSWER

(a) Department of Animal Husbandry & Dairying (DAHD) is implementing National Programme for Dairy Development (NPDD) since 2014-15 with the objective to create dairy infrastructure to improve milk procurement, processing and marketing in cooperative dairy sector across the country. Quality Milk Programme under NPDD scheme was launched during 2019-20 to help check milk adulteration and contamination on a priority basis, across the country. During the current financial year, DAHD has prioritised projects under NPDD scheme primarily for setting up of bulk milk coolers and strengthening of milk testing facilities to ensure farmers to greater market access, quality milk production and food safety of consumers.

(b) & (c) 1786 number of bulk milk coolers have been established at the village level dairy cooperative societies. Milk testing laboratories at Dairy Plant level and Village level Cooperative societies have been strengthened primarily with installation of 42 FTIR Technology based Milk Analyser, 1760 Electronic Milk Analyser with adulteration testing equipment and 13,261 Automatic Milk Collection Unit (AMCU)/Data Processing and Milk Collection Unit (DPMCU). State-wise details of bulk milk coolers and major milk testing equipments installed under the programme is given at **Annexure**.
