VACCINATION OF HALF OF THE COUNTRY'S POPULATION

3141 SHRI K.J. ALPHONS:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) by when does Government expects half of the population of the country to be vaccinated;
- (b) by when the vaccination of those above 60 yrs and those above 50 yrs with comorbidities will be completed; and
- (c) whether Government has planned to provide vaccination at home to those who find difficulty in moving?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY)

- (a) & (b): The COVID-19 vaccination is an ongoing and dynamic process, which is being expanded to include beneficiary groups as prioritized by National Expert Group on Vaccine Administration for COVID-19 (NEGVAC). In view of the dynamic and evolving nature of COVID-19 pandemic and inclusion of private COVID-19 Vaccination Centres, no fixed timeline at present can be indicated for the completion of vaccination drive.
- (c): Presently, COVID-19 vaccination is being provided at Government and Private COVID-19 Vaccination Centres (CVCs) only.
