(a) Sir, the Department of Biotechnology (DBT) has partnered with various State Governments to establish Biotech Parks since 2003. It has helped to translate research into products and services by providing necessary infrastructure support. These parks are successfully accelerating the commercialization of new technologies, assisting new enterprises to forge appropriate linkages with other stakeholder of biotechnology sector including academia, industry and Government. DBT has supported establishment of nine Biotechnology Parks in different State and UTs. The details are given below:
