#### **Enrolment of students in various classes**

#### 372 SHRIHARNATH SINGH YADAV:

Will the Minister of *Education*be pleased to state:

- (a)the number of students studying in classes Fifth, Eighth and Eleventh as on date, State-wise; and
- (b) the details of measures taken to make students continue their education along with skills training after Eighth and Tenth classes and the number of such students, State-wise?

#### **ANSWER**

### MINISTER OF EDUCATION (SHRI RAMESH POKHRIYAL 'NISHANK')

- (a) As per Unified District Information System for Education Plus (U-DISE+) 2018-19, the number of students studying in classes Fifth, Eighth and Eleventh, Statewise is given at **Annexure-I**.
- (b) Government has undertaken various measures to make studentscontinue their education along with skills training. Department of School Education and Literacy, Ministry of Education is implementing the scheme of Vocationalisation of School Education under the umbrella of 'Samagra Shiksha an integrated scheme for school education', a Centrally Sponsored Scheme. The scheme seeks to integrate vocational education with general academic education with an aim to prepare educated, employable and competitive human resource for various sectors of the economy. Vocational courses are taught to the students of class 9th to 12th who opt for vocational subject in the schools covered under the scheme. The scheme is being implemented in 32 States/UTs with more than 11 lakh students. The number of such students State/UT-wise is given at Annexure-II.
