With a view to fill the gap of research studies on tribal issues, Ministry of Tribal Affairs, under a component "Financial Assistance for Support to Centre of Excellence" of the Scheme "Tribal Festival, Research Information and Mass Education" recognizes renowned NGOs, Research Institutes, Universities where expertise exist and which have already made a mark by carrying out pioneering research in the field of tribal cultures as Centre of Excellences (CoEs). Funds are not provided to States under this Scheme. Financial assistance provided to the CoEs during the last three years is annexed.
