Beneficiaries from Stand Up India Scheme

851. SHRI SHWAIT MALIK:

Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

(a) whether a large number of people have been benefited since the launch of 'Stand up India' scheme under which beneficiaries can get a loan of ₹ 10 lakh to rupees one crore to start or increase their business; and

(b) if so, the details thereof including the number of such beneficiaries in Punjab since its implementation, District-wise?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI ANURAG SINGH THAKUR)

(a) to (b) Stand Up India Scheme was launched by the Government on 5th April, 2016 and subsequently extended up to the year 2025. The Scheme facilitates bank loans between Rs. 10 lakh and Rs. 1 crore to at least one Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe borrower and at least one woman borrower, per bank branch of Scheduled Commercial Banks (SCBs), for setting up greenfield enterprises in the manufacturing, services or the trading sectors. Over 1,10,019 loans have been extended under the Scheme as on 31.01.2021 since inception.

District-wise details of loans extended under the Scheme in the State of Punjab, as on 31th January, 2021, is placed at the Annexure.
