SEAT CREATION FOR PG COURSES IN MEDICAL COLLEGES

- (a) the number of seats created for PG courses in medical colleges in the country during the past five years
- (b) the number of posts that are proposed to be created over the next five years and
- (c) the number of super specialty seats that are proposed to be created over the next five years?

(a): During the last five years from 2015-16 to 2020-21, 16193 PG Seats and 5092 DNB/FNB seats have been created in medical colleges in the country.

(b): The post for the specialist doctors are created by the respective State Governments/Union Territories.

(c): The proposals for creation of Broad-specialty and Super-specialty seats emanates from respective institutions and thereafter permitted by the National Medical Commission after regulatory mechanism.
