NURTURING NEIGHBOURHOODS CHALLENGE UNDER SCM

NO. 2464 SHRI B. LINGAIAH YADAV:

Will the Minister of *Housing and Urban Affairs* be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has finalised the names of the 25 cities selected for the Nurturing Neighbourhoods Challenge under the Smart Cities Mission (SCM) and the shortlisted cities would carry out projects for making early childhood friendly neighbourhoods, including Hyderabad, Kakinada and Warangal etc.; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the progress made State-wise and city-wise?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) OF THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI HARDEEP SINGH PURI)

(a) & (b) Yes, Sir. The Nurturing Neighbourhoods Challenge is an initiative of the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs to sensitize, guide and enable Indian cities to adopt an early-childhood lens in designing neighbourhoods in order to promote health and well-being of young children and their caregivers. Participation in the Challenge was made open to all Smart Cities, all Capital cities and all cities above 500,000 in population. After the initial period of handholding and submission of applications, 25 cities have been selected through a competitive process to proceed to Phase-I of the pilot stage of the Challenge. A jury has been constituted to evaluate the proposals of the selected 25 cities. The selected cities have started mobilizing nodal persons and/or teams to initiate actions under Phase-I of the Challenge. The details of these cities is given in Annexure-I.
