TRAINING TO ENHANCE SKILLS OF WEAVERS

3480. SHRI NEERAJ DANGI:

Will the Minister of TEXTILES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has any scheme for imparting modern skill training to the weavers;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the details of the number of weavers who have been provided skill training during the last three years, State-wise;
- (d) the name of institutes with which a contract has been signed for skill training; and
- (e) the number of weavers who have been provided skill training in Rajasthan and the name of institutes with which contract has been signed, the district-wise details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF TEXTILES (SMT. SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

(a) to (e): Skill upgradation is a continuous process. Need-based skill upgradation programmes for handloom workers in technical areas viz. weaving, dyeing, designing, etc. were earlier conducted under National Handloom Development Programme (NHDP), Comprehensive Handloom Cluster Development Scheme (CHCDS) and now under SAMARTH- Capacity Building in Textile Sector. Training programmes for handloom workers are conducted through 28 Weavers' Service Centres (WSCs) functioning in the country under administrative control of Ministry of Textiles. List of WSCs and State-wise details of handloom workers imparted skill upgradation training including in State of Rajasthan from financial year 2017-18 to 2019-20 are annexed as Annexure- I and II respectively.
