- (a)whether Labour Bureau is all set to launch its five major surveys including on migrant and domestic workers across the country as two out of three mandated pre-testings of the studies yielded encouraging and positive results; and
- (b)if so, the details thereof and present status thereof, survey-wise, State-wise?

- (a) & (b): Labour Bureau, an attached office of the Ministry of Labour & Employment is going to launch the following five All- India Surveys to be conducted in all States/UTs:
 - (i) All India Survey on Migrant Workers;
 - (ii) All India Survey on Domestic Workers;
 - (iii) All India Survey on Employment generated by Professionals
 - (iv) All India Survey on Employment generated in the Transport Sector and
 - (v) All India Quarterly Establishment based Employment Survey (AQEES).

The pre-testing of schedules in respect of all these surveys is being carried out from time to time as per requirement.
