(a) The National Sports Talent Contest (NSTC) scheme being implemented by the Sports Authority of India (SAI), comprises Regular Schools, Indigenous Games and Martial Arts centres and adopted Akharas. There are no adopted schools or akharas in State of West Bengal.
