- (a) the response received under the Vande Bharat Mission (VBM), which started repatriating Indian stranded abroad due to COVID-19 and the resultant lockdown till today has turned out to be one of the largest evacuations of civilians; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof, country-wise and flight-wise?

(a) & (b) During the global Covid-19 pandemic, the Government of India has undertaken the Vande Bharat Mission (including air bubble arrangements) to facilitate travel of passengers between India and various parts of the world.

As on 29.07.2021, more than 88,700 inbound flights have been operated and over 72 lakh passengers have returned to India from more than 100 countries. In the same period, more than 88,000 outbound flights have been operated and over 58 lakh passengers have traveled from India to foreign countries.
