Will the Minister of Housing And Urban Affairs be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Government of Kerala has submitted proposals for approval of Phase II of Kochi Metro, Trivandrum light metro and Calicut light metro; and
- (b) if so, the status of each project and the likely date of approvals to be granted, details thereof?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI KAUSHAL KISHORE)

- (a) Yes, Sir. Government of Kerala has submitted proposals for approval of Phase II of Kochi Metro, Trivandrum light metro and Calicut light metro.
- (b) The above proposals are at various stages of appraisal/approval. Further, Metro Rail projects are cost intensive which require appraisal in terms of Metro Rail Policy, 2017, extensive Inter-Ministerial consultations and their approval depends on feasibility of projects and availability of resources. Hence, no time limit can be specified for grant of approval of these projects.
