REGIONAL AND TERTIARY CANCER CARE CENTRES

2506. SHRI VIJAY PAL SINGH TOMAR: SHRI HARNATH SINGH YADAV: LT. GEN. (DR.) D.P. VATS (RETD.):

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has any plan to expedite the process of starting more regional cancer care centres and tertiary cancer care centres in the country in view of the increasing cases of cancer patients in the country, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether Government has provided adequate funds and logistic support to various States/Union Territories in the country to start such cancer care centres, if so, the details thereof, State-wise; and
- (c) the steps taken by Government to start cancer care centres and Palliative care centres in the country?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SMT. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

(a) to (c): Health is a state subject. The Department of Health & Family Welfare, however, provides technical and financial support to the States/UTs under the National Programme for Prevention and Control of Cancer, Diabetes, Cardiovascular Diseases and Stroke (NPCDCS), as part of National Health Mission (NHM), based on the proposals received from the States/UTs and subject to the resource envelope. Cancer is an integral part of NPCDCS. The programme focusses on strengthening infrastructure, human resource development, health promotion & awareness generation for Cancer prevention, early diagnosis, management and referral to an appropriate level of healthcare facility for treatment of the Non-Communicable Diseases, including Cancer.

The Central Government is also implementing Strengthening of Tertiary Care of Cancer Scheme in order to enhance the facilities for tertiary care of cancer. 19 State Cancer Institutes (SCIs) and 20 Tertiary Care Cancer Centres (TCCCs) have been approved so far under the said scheme. List of the said SCIs and TCCCs along with the financial assistance provided to the States/UTs concerned is attached as **Annexure I.**

There is also focus on Oncology in its various aspects in case of new AIIMS and many upgraded institutions under Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojna (PMSSY). Setting up of National Cancer Institute at Jhajjar (Haryana) and second campus of Chittaranjan National Cancer Institute, Kolkata are also steps in this direction. All these will enhance the capacity for treatment of cancer in the country.

The treatment for in-patient care is also available under Ayushman Bharat - Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (PMJAY) for 10.74 crore families eligible under AB-PMJAY as per Socio Economic Caste Census (SECC) database.

In order to provide palliative care services to the needy patients and integrate them with the public healthcare system at district and sub-district levels, the Government is implementing National Program for Palliative Care (NPPC), under the aegis of NHM. Technical and financial support is provided to the States/UTs based on the proposals received from them, subject to the resource envelope. Till date 456 districts/centres for palliative care in 27 states/UTs have been supported under the NPPC. The program is providing palliative care services to patients, who face life-threatening illnesses including cancer, and to their families in the form of pain and symptom relief, and psychological support.
