(a) Ministry of Tribal Affairs (MoTA) has sanctioned projects to construct museums of national importance for tribal freedom fighters in the States of Gujarat and Jharkhand under the scheme of 'Support to Tribal Research Institutes' to acknowledge the heroic and patriotic deeds of tribal people who struggled against the Britishers and refused to be bowed down so that the coming generations may know how tribals were involved in making sacrifices for the nation.
