Specified category schools

379 SHRI TIRUCHI SIVA:

Will the Minister of *Education* be pleased to state:

- (a) the list of specified category schools that have been notified by Government under Sec 2 (n)(iii) of the Right to Education Act, 2009 as of 2020;
- (b) whether these specified category schools charge any amount from parents for classes IX-XII, and if so, the details of each school with the split up of the amount charged from parents belonging to these schools; and
- (c) whether there was a committee set up that suggested the charging of the above mentioned amounts, if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF EDUCATION (SHRI DHARMENDRA PRADHAN)

- (a) As per Section 2 (p) of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 'specified category', in relation to a school, means a school known as Kendriya Vidyalaya, Navodaya Vidyalaya, Sainik School or any other school having a distinct character which may be specified, by notification, by the appropriate Government. Vide notification dated 19/01/2011, Central Tibetan Schools Administration (CTSA) has been defined as specified category schools for the purposes of the said Act.
- (b) The fees charged in these category of schools are as per following fee structures:-

Note: Exemption of various types of fees mentioned above will not be allowed henceforth to the children of Government employees as they are getting reimbursement from their departments.

Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya (JNV) - No tuition fee is charged from the students of JNVs. However, a nominal amount is collected as Vidyalaya Vikas Nidhi (VVN) from the students of class IX to XII, as under:-

- @ Rs. 600/- per student per month (except from the students of exempted category).
- @ Rs. 1500/- per student per month in respect of wards of Govt. employees (other than exempted category) or actual amount of Children Education Allowance received, whichever is less. However, VVN charged shall not be less than @ Rs. 600/-per month.

Following categories of students are exempted for paying the Vidyalaya Vikas Nidhi:

- (i) All students from Classes VI to VIII.
- (ii) All girl students.
- (iii) Students belonging to SC category.

- (iv) Students belonging to ST category.
- (v) Students belonging to BPL category.

Central Tibetan Schools Administration (CTSA): CTSA is providing free education to the wards of Tibetan Refugee in India alongwith 10% local Indian students and hence no fee is charged from any student.

Sainik Schools Society: In Sainik Schools applicable tuition fee for the year 2019-20 and 2020-21 is Rs. 79,860/-. Other components including dietary charges are being charged by respective schools as per actuals.

(c) The above fee charges in KVs have been approved by the Board of Governors of Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan. In JNVs, Vidyalaya Vikas Nidhi was initially introduced on the recommendations contained in 9th Report of Expenditure Reforms Commission, Government of India dated 10th July, 2000. No such committee was set up to suggest for charging fees in Sainik Schools.
