**Statement referred to in reply of Rajya Sabha Starred Question No. 8 to be answered on 19.07.2021**

Government of India, in partnership with States/ UTs, is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) - Har Ghar Jal to enable every rural household in the country to have potable water in adequate quantity of prescribed quality, on regular and long-term basis through tap water connection, by 2024.

At the time of announcement of Jal Jeevan Mission on 15th August, 2019, out of 18.93 Crore rural households, 3.23 Crore households (17.07%) were reported to have tap water supply. Since then, over 4.48 Crore (23.65%) families living in rural areas have been provided with tap water connections in their homes. As on 13.07.2021, about 7.71 Crore (40.72%) rural households are having tap water supply. States of Goa & Telangana and Union Territories (UTs) of Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Puducherry have become 'Har Ghar Jal Rajya/ UT'. State/ UT –wise details of tap water connections in rural households are **annexed**.
