466. SHRI BHASKAR RAO NEKKANTI:

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether One Stop Centres have been set up in districts of the State of Odisha, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the total funds allocated, released, sanctioned, and utilized under the said scheme along with the percentage of funds utilized by these centres, in these districts for Financial Year 2020-21;
- (c) whether Government has proposed to upgrade or introduce a new scheme to improve the condition of women affected by the violence of any kind under One Stop Centres particularly in Odisha; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons, therefor?

ANSWER

(a) & (b) : Yes sir. One Stop Centres (OSCs) have been set up in 30 districts of Odisha. The details of total funds released and utilized under the said scheme along with the percentage of funds utilized by these centres, in these districts for Financial Year 2020-21 are at **Annexure**.

(c) and (d) : Review of schemes is a continuous process and the Government takes appropriate measures from time to time for making required modifications/ changes in its schemes. In this direction, the Ministry has decided to implement the Umbrella Scheme for Safety, Security and Empowerment of Women under the name 'Mission Shakti', with One Stop Centres and other components for improving the condition of women affected by violence for the entire country, including Odisha.
