PEOPLE HAVING ACCESS TO PIPED DRINKING WATER

76. SHRI BHASKAR RAO NEKKANTI:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) the total percentage of people in the country having access to piped drinking water as on date; and
- (b) the percentage of people having access to piped drinking water, State-wise?

ANSWER

(a) & (b) Government of India is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) in partnership with States to make provision of assured piped water supply in adequate quantity and of prescribed quality on regular and long-term basis through tap water connection to every rural household by 2024. Under Jal Jeevan Mission, the coverage is monitored in terms of number of households with provision of tap water supply.

At the time of announcement of Jal Jeevan Mission on 15th August 2019, out of 18.93 Crore rural households, 3.23 Crore households (17%) were reported to have provision of tap water supply. Since then, more than 4.48 Crore rural households have been provided tap water connections till date. As on 13.7.2021, more than 7.72 Crore (40.77%) households have tap water supply in their homes.
