PROPOSAL TO SETUP INTEGRATED HOSPITALS UNDER NATIONAL AYUSH MISSION

172 SHRI RAM VICHAR NETAM:

Will the Minister of **AYUSH** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government proposes to set up integrated hospitals of upto 50 beds under the National AYUSH Mission in the country;
- (b) if so, the number of hospitals proposed to be set up in Chhattisgarh under this scheme, district-wise;
- (c) whether the said hospitals will be equipped with Inpatient Department (IPD) facility; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and, if not the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF AYURVEDA, YOGA & NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY (SHRI MAHENDRABHAI MUNJAPARA)

- (a): As public health is a State subject, opening of integrated hospitals in different States/UTs of the country including Chhattisgarh comes under the respective State/UT Government's purview. However, under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National AYUSH Mission (NAM), there is a provision for financial assistance for setting up of up to 50-bedded integrated AYUSH Hospital. Under NAM, grant-in-aid is being provided to State/UT Governments as per the proposals submitted through State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs).
- (b): As per the proposal received through SAAP during the year 2020-21, the State Government of Chhattisgarh has been supported to establish eight up to 50 bedded integrated AYUSH Hospitals at Janjgir Champa, Mahasamund, Koria, Korba, Kanker, Narayanpur, Bijapur and Dantewada Districts.
- (c) & (d): Further, under the component of setting up of up to 50-bedded integrated AYUSH Hospital, provision has also been made for equipping the hospital with essential diagnostic facilities, drugs, equipment and furniture to provide Inpatient Department (IPD) facility.
