**COTTON MILLS IN TIRUPATI**

- (a) whether Tirupati Cotton Mills in Tirupati, Andhra Pradesh, which was closed due to lockdown has been reopened;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the details of unsold finished goods lying in the above mill and the steps taken to liquidate them by the Ministry?
