IMPLEMENTATION OF ODOP IN RAJASTHAN

533. DR. KIRODI LAL MEENA:

Will the Minister of Commerce and Industry be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the Central Government has implemented the "One District, One Product" (ODOP) scheme in different States of the country, if so, the productwise and district-wise details of the scheme implemented in Rajasthan;
- (b) whether it is also a fact that under the said scheme, export plan has been prepared in the Export Promotion Committee for all 33 districts of Rajasthan; and
- (c) if so, whether State Government has submitted the report to the Central Government, if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE & INDUSTRY (SHRI SOM PARKASH)

(a): The Central Government has implemented the One District One Product (ODOP) initiative in different States of the country. ODOP is an initiative which is seen as a transformational step forward towards realizing the true potential of a district, fuel economic growth and generate employment and rural entrepreneurship, taking us to the goal of AtmaNirbhar Bharat. ODOP initiative is operationally merged with 'Districts as Export Hub' initiative being implemented by DGFT, Department of Commerce, with Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT) as a major stakeholder.

The district-wise details of products under One District One Product (ODOP) initiative in Rajasthan are available at **Annexure.**

(b) & (c): To increase exports and take export promotion to the District level, Department of Commerce through the Director General of Foreign Trade (DGFT) is engaging with State/ UT Governments to implement the said initiative in all districts of the country in a phased manner, with the objective of mobilizing the potential of each district of the country to achieve its potential as an export hub.

Under ODOP initiative, Draft Export Action Plans have been prepared for all the districts of Rajasthan except Jhalawar. Draft Action Plans prepared by Regional Authorities of Directorate General of Foreign Trade at Jaipur have been submitted to State Government of Rajasthan for preparing and notifying final action plan for the districts.
