STATUS OF GREEN NHS CORRIDOR PROJECT

140. SHRI SUSHIL KUMAR GUPTA:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Government had signed an agreement with the World Bank to develop a Green National Highways (NHs) Corridor Project;
- (b) if so, the present status of progress of this project and timeline for completion; and
- (c) the names of the States to be covered under it?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) Yes Sir. The Government had signed loan agreement with the World Bank to develop Green National Highway Corridors (GNHCP). The project include Upgradation of about 781 km length of various National Highways passing through the states of Rajasthan, Himachal Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh and Andhra Pradesh. Out of total length of 781 km, work on 287.96 km having Civil Cost of Rs. 1664.44 cr. has been awarded. The schedule date of completion is December, 2025.
