IMPLEMENTATION OF PMKSY IN KARNATAKA

581. SHRI IRANNA KADADI:

Will the Minister of Food Processing Industries be pleased to state:

- (a) the details on the number of Mega and Mini Food Parks, Cold Chain Infrastructure and Food Testing Laboratories established under the Pradhan Mantri Kisan SAMPADA Yojana (PMKSY), State-wise including Karnataka;
- (b) the details of the financial allocation and the investment made to improve food processing infrastructure under the said scheme in Karnataka;
- (c) the details of the schemes under the Ministry for promoting processing of citrus fruits and details of the funds released to Karnataka under the same; and
- (d) whether Government has made any assessment of the number of farmers benefited/getting benefit from this scheme in Karnataka?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES (SHRI PRAHLAD SINGH PATEL)

(a) to (d): Ministry of Food Processing Industries (MoFPI) has been implementing a Central Sector umbrella scheme – Pradhan Mantri Kisan SAMPADA Yojana (PMKSY) for overall growth and development of food processing sector across the country including in the state of Karnataka. The State-wise number of Mega Food Parks, Agro Processing clusters (Mini Food Parks), Integrated Cold Chains and Food Testing Laboratories approved/completed under respective component schemes of PMKSY is placed at Annexure-I. The details of such projects located in Karnataka along with estimation of farmers benefited is placed at Annexure-II. Citrus fruit based projects are also eligible for assistance under PMKSY.

As part of Aatmanirbhar Bharat initiative, MoFPI is implementing centrally sponsored "PM Formalization of Micro Food Processing Enterprises (PMFME) Scheme" for providing financial, technical and business support for upgradation/ setting up of two lakh micro food processing units based on One District One Product (ODOP) approach in a period of five years from 2020-21 to 2024-25 with an outlay of Rs. 10,000 crores. Out of this, a total of 10,784 units have been allocated to Karnataka for next five years. Lime/ Lemon has been identified as ODOP for Vijaypara district in Karnataka and Rs. 33.73 Cr. have been released to the State under the scheme so far.
