(a) whether Government had identified families of agricultural labourers whose livelihood primarily depended upon the lands that have been acquired for Polavaram Irrigation Project (PIP);

(b) if so, details of the families of agricultural labourers who have been affected due to PIP, Mandal-wise in the State of Andhra Pradesh;

(c) whether Government has paid any compensation to the agricultural labourers whose livelihood

primarily depended upon the lands that have been acquired for PIP;

(d) if so, the details thereof, and

(e) if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) & (b) The details provided by Government of Andhra Pradesh (GoAP), are as below:

(c) to (e) GoAP has informed that these families are considered as Project Displaced Families (PDFs), and compensation under 2nd Schedule of Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation & Resettlement Act, 2013 is being paid.

For Polavaram project, 1,06,006 PDFs have been identified. Out of this, 3,601 PDFs have been shifted so far, and an amount of Rs.1123.01 crore has been incurred towards Resettlement & Rehabilitation cash entitlements and Housing & Infra works.
