(c) the annual production of the above mentioned devices in the country at present; and

(d) the target set for the installation of such devices in the country by the year 2013, year-wise?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI R. VELU): (a) Anti-Collision Device (ACD) is proposed to be installed over the entire Broad Gauge (BG) Network of Indian Railway.

(b) Requirement of about 57,000 ACDs is estimated on BG network of Indian Railway.

(c) ACDs are at present being provided/supplied by M/s Konkan Railway Corporation Limited in association with M/s Kernex Microsystems (India) Ltd. So far about 2,300 ACDs have been supplied during last about three years.

(d) Installation of Anti-collision Device (ACD) on Katihar-Dibrugarh-Ledo section of North-east Frontier Railway (NFR) has been done and after successful completion of the project on NFR, it is proposed to provide the ACD system over the entire BG network of Indian Railway by 2013-14.

## Construction of new overbridges in Assam
